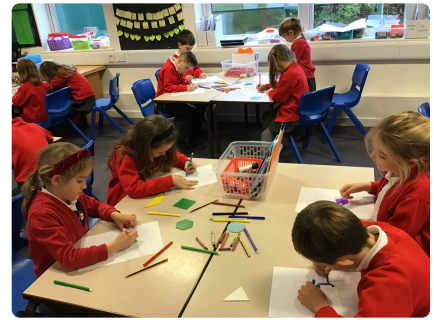
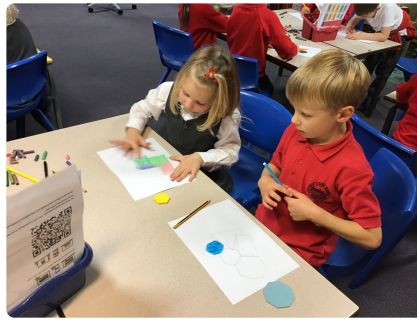
Children's Absence

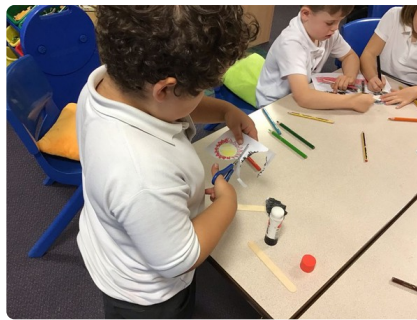
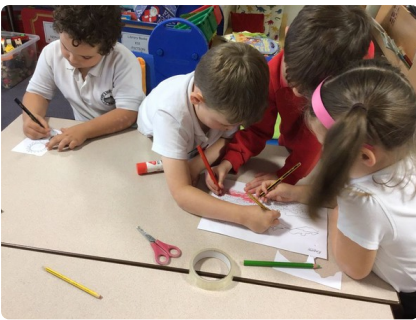
Technology and Art Across the School

Lots of practical, hands-on learning is happening across the school, particularly in Design Technology and Art.

In art, Year 1 and 2 have been experimenting with media. They have drawn around various 2D shapes overlapping each other and used different materials such as chalk and pastels to add colour. They also looked at different techniques of holding the materials to create different effects and learnt to smudge chalk carefully.



In DT, Years 1 and 2 are working on slider mechanisms to create a moving picture book whilst years 3,4 and 4 are learning about pneumatics to create a moving monster! Year 6 are perfecting their textiles work by designing and making draft excluders which are also designed to save some energy bills!

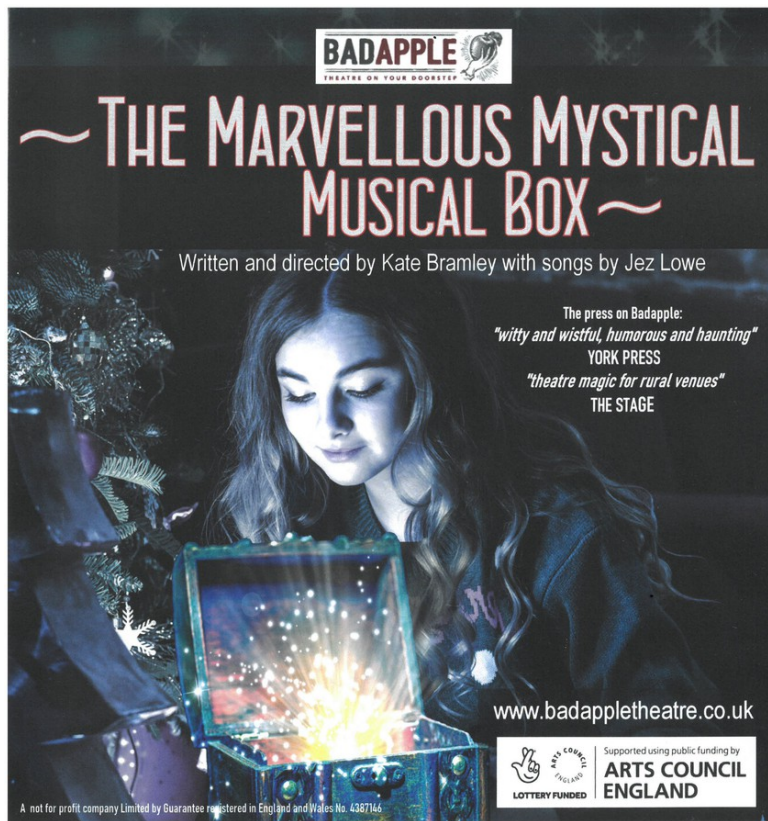
