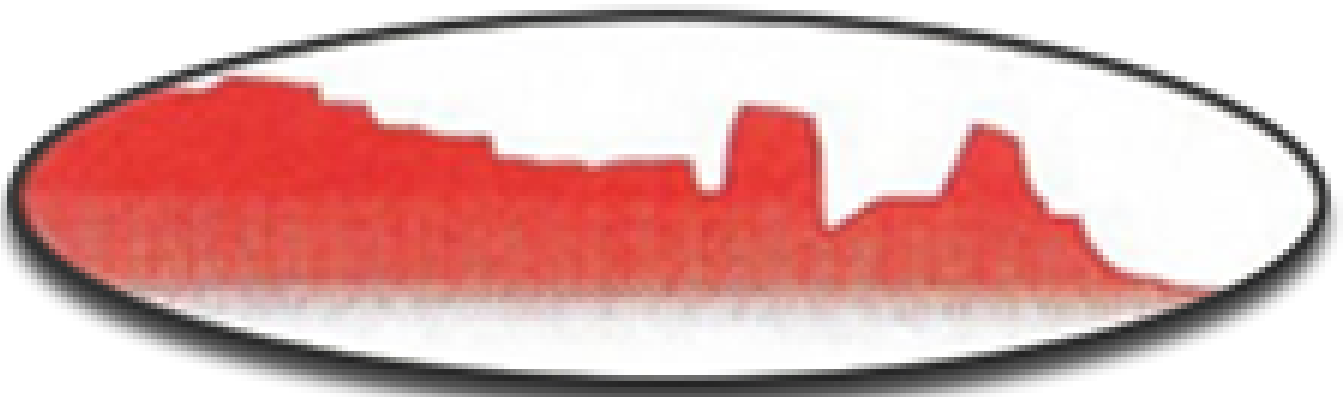

## Our Bible Service

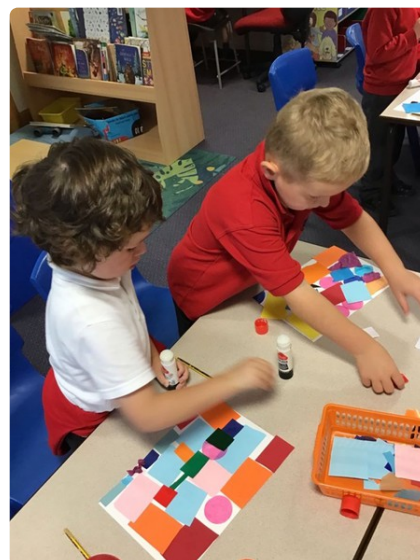
